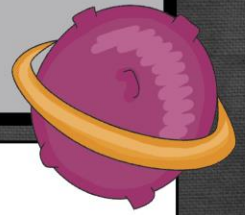

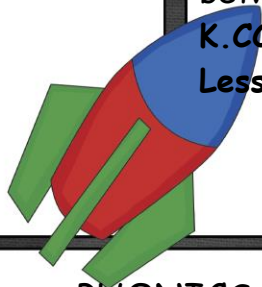

Your child needs to be familiar with the terms, beginning, medial, and final, use these terms when referring to sounds in words.

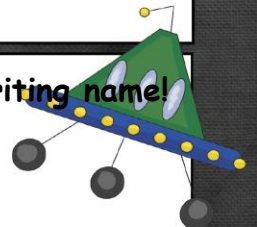
